Sir,

I am directed to say that the Central Government, after consultation with the Medical Council of India, has decided to recognise for the purpose of IMC Act, 1956 the MBBS degree awarded by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences to the students being trained at Guru Ram Das Inst. of Medical Sciences & Research, Sri Amritsar in or after January, 2002, with an annual intake capacity of 50 students. However, in case of application for any further increase in intake capacity or to run the PG courses at the institution, the College authorities will have to provide in the proposal a hospital situated in the campus of the college as per the provisions of IMC Act and Regulations.

The MBBS degree granted by the Baba Farid University of Health Sciences is already a recognised qualification and included in the Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.
